



Project Management Course

Project management is about planning, organising and managing resources to bring about the successful and timely completion of specific project goals and objectives.

Project management includes developing a project plan, which includes defining and confirming the project goals and objectives, identifying tasks and how goals will be achieved, quantifying the resources needed, and determining budgets and timelines for completion.

Projects are usually a temporary endeavour having a defined beginning and end. They are undertaken to meet aims that bring about beneficial change or added value.

The primary challenge of project management is to achieve all of the defined project goals within the defined project constraints which typically are time, budget and scope. It is to optimise the input necessary to meet pre-defined objectives.

Project management has emerged as a crucial factor that determines the success of an organisation. Whether it is a question of facing an economic crisis or generating large turnover, project management plays a pivotal role in the growth of a company.
